Nancy Bloomer Deussen read Minutes from August 2 Meeting <u>Treasurer's Report</u>
Karl gave treasurer's report.
We have a bank balance of \$3,349.43
Our projected expenses for 2016 are \$6,065.00

We discussed our problem with the IRS as a result of the national chapter in Los Angeles leaving us off the list of chapters when they renewed with the IRS. We applied for and got a new number which was rejected by the IRS. We are trying to solve this problem by doing the long form 501C3 which is a tedious, complicated process. Herb volunteered to help Karl fill out this form. We discussed needing a new board in order to file with the IRS and we also need by-laws. We have some by-laws that were worked out in a committee with Jeff Dunn and we believe he still has these. We selected a temporary Board to fill the requirement of having a board. It is:

President: John Beeman,

VP: Dale Victorine

Secretary: Nancy Bloomer Deussen

Treasurer: Karl Schmidt

Other possible solutions were suggested as a way to solve our IRS problem such as having a large organization as a fiscal sponsor. They would do all our taxes and insurance but would take 7% out of our mone.

We will attempt again to work with national to get reinstatement.

<u>Membership</u>

We discussed what measures we can take to increase membership. Dale will do publicity on-line. Dale mentioned the Monterey group who meet once a month. John volunteered to make "membership" posters inviting new people to join and Nancy volunteered to put them up in college and university music departments.

We would like to put a requirement on the score call to attend the concert but this is difficult for out of area composers. So we decided on this wording: "Preference will be given to composers who can attend the concert". John made a motion to that effect, Karl seconded it and it was passed.

We discussed a possible "informal" venue for salon concerts. We need someone to put together a data base of musical organizations in the area.

We discussed changing the concert time of the Menlo Brass concert to 7:00 PM at The First Baptist Church but no action was taken.
